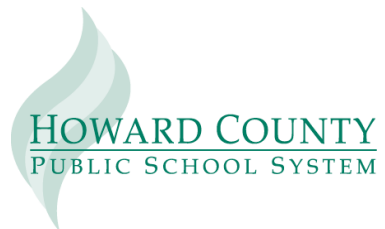


PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR SECONDARY LIBRARY MEDIA SPECIALISTS 2010 - 2011
